Corona repercussions

- The **first day of school festivities** for 5th graders will take place while observing all hygiene principles against infectious diseases, the school announced. This concept worked very well for the Abitur festivities in June in the school yard, with social distancing, disposable gloves and elbow checks.
- International travel programs and meetings will only slowly and gradually return to normal the same goes for domestic school trips as well as music and sports events.
- Paulinum conducted a <u>poll</u> regarding **distance learning** in Corona times. Overall, the results show great satisfaction among the students, the school says. Paulinum is now working on integrating the lessons learned during the Corona experience into regular schooling from this year on.

PAOLO welcomes this decision. However, we think that our children would benefit most from learning in attendance classes again. A direct exchange within the class is particularly important for children with little or no knowledge of the German language.

Parents' conferences: At the beginning of the school year, German schools host parents' conferences ("Klassenpflegschaftssitzungen") for all grades. Parents of a class or a year get together to talk about important topics and to elect their representatives. Class teachers also participate in these meetings.
