- Good German skills are a mandatory requirement for a successful Abitur. Therefore **studying German is a priority** for international students during their first two years at Paulinum. Sometimes DaZ classes are scheduled at the same time as regular lessons.
- Some parents worry that their children may miss too much regular class time. However, in our experience this perceived disadvantage is by far outweighed by the long-term advantages of improved German skills.
